Orthopedic Services

Maury Regional Health offers a wide array of orthopedic services to reduce pain and improve quality of life. The majority of surgical procedures are performed at Maury Regional Medical Center in Columbia with outpatient services at many of our sites throughout the region.

Joint Replacement

The skilled and experienced surgeons on our medical staff perform progressive joint replacement procedures for the knee, hip, shoulder and elbow at Maury Regional Medical Center. Physicians evaluate patients to determine what procedure and device best meet the patient's individual needs. Among the options available are:

- Total hip replacement (traditional, anterior approach and Mako robotic-arm assisted)
- Total and partial knee replacement (traditional and Mako robotic-arm assisted)
- Gender-specific knee replacement
- Total shoulder replacement
- Reverse total shoulder replacement
- Elbow replacement
- Ankle replacement



Spine Procedures

Surgeons on the medical staff have extensive experience repairing lumbar, thoracic and cervical damage and/or conditions of the spine. Procedures performed include:

- Artificial disc replacement
- Cervical foraminotomy
- Discectomy and microdiscectomy
- Fusion (anterior, posterior and lateral)
- Kyphoplasty
- Laminectomy
- Laminoplasty
- Osteotomies and deformity re-alignment

Minimally Invasive Repairs

In addition to expertise in joint replacements and spinal surgeries, the surgeons on the medical staff also perform minimally invasive procedures to repair:

- Cartilage
- Rotator Cuff
- Ligaments
- Tendons
- Carpal Tunnel

Patient Care and Safety

Our goal is to help patients return to home as quickly as possible while ensuring their safety and success. These measures include:

- Joint Replacement Class: Maury Regional Medical Center offers joint replacement classes prior to surgery to educate patients regarding the procedure, pre-surgery exercise, infection control precautions, physical therapy, discharge planning and much more. Patients will also learn from individuals who have already had joint replacement surgery.
- Mobility: Members of the nursing staff, many of whom have additional certification in orthopedics, quickly begin ambulating patients while taking measures to reduce the likelihood of falls post-surgery. The physical therapy staff will ambulate the patient the day of surgery and progress to a designated walking goal individualized to the patient by the date of discharge.

Our goal is for the patient to be discharged home; however, the individual needs of each patient will vary and are determined by the patient and physician.

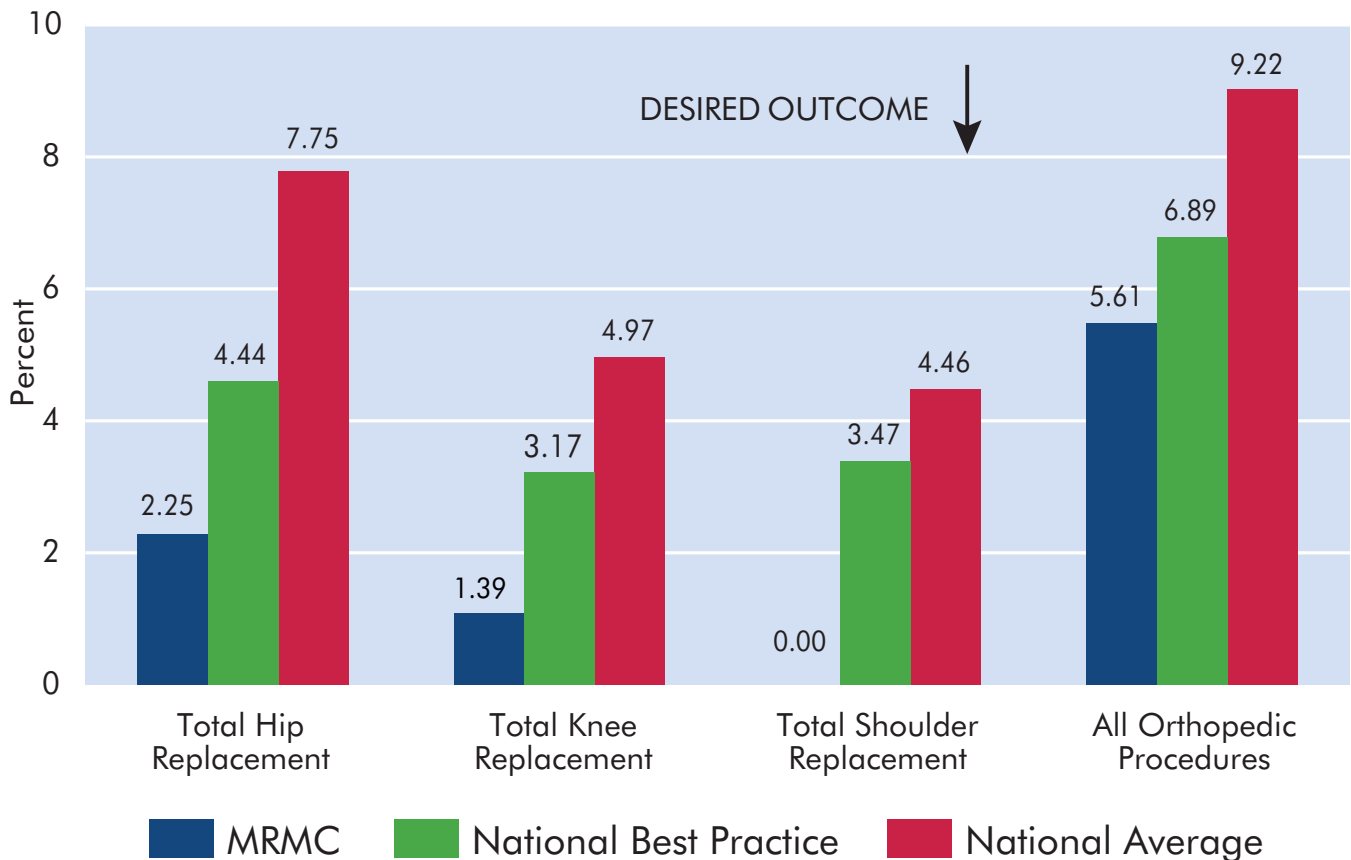
